THE OLD BROOKS PLACE

The Old Brooks Place has been home to Mr. and Mrs. Tom Clarkson since December of 1941, the day before Pearl Harbor. It is believed to have been built in the 1850's and was home at that time to a man with a very colorful name, Alexander Napoleon Bonapart Brooks. He was son of William W. Brooks and grandson of Christopher Brooks of Franklin County, North Carolina. Brooks married Mary Jane McCay, a daughter of John P. McCay, one of the county's finest settlers. The house was moved a few feet in 1907 to make room for the tracks of the Franklin Interburban, which ran through the front yard. The staircase in the house is solid Walnut.
