- Fiery Gizzard, a hiker's paradise of panoramic views in the South Cumberlands
- Rocky Fork, a 10,000-acre stretch of wilderness adventure in the Southern Appalachians
- Radnor Lake State Natural Area, a popular natural area in Nashville
- Bridgestone-Firestone Centennial Wilderness Area, a 10,000-acre getaway along the Caney Fork River; and
- Fall Creek Falls State Park, a dizzying mix of steep waterfalls and deep gorges on the Cumberland Plateau
